

Trial of Plant of Health® Plant Assist™ & MPB-1™ Microbial Pro Biotic on *eleocharis spacelata*

Cherylle Allison of Belle Jardin Garden Care did an observational trial of our [Plant Assist™](#) and our microbial probiotic [MPB-1](#) on some *Eleocharis spacelata* at the production nursery where she works. The Plant Assist is more designed for when planting out tubes, plants and trees into marginal soil, but she trialled it anyway in the potting mix.

CURRENT USERS and TRIALS.

Plant Assist was developed in 2017 following a request by the manager Paul, from Paten Park Native Nursery (formally Greening Australia production/retail nursery) wanting a planting product that reduces transplant shock when planting native tubes, plants and trees in re-veg programs. He initially raised the issue of seedling loss in this section of the industry. The final blend tested was released in March 2018 and was immediately well accepted. Paul highly recommends Plant Assist now to contractors and the public alike when planting his native tubes, plants & trees.

A major NSW landscaping company, via one of our local distributors, initially purchased a 10kg tub to trial, the next order, some 6 months later, was 100kgs, now regularly buys 1 tonne pallets.

Northern Tropical Plants, a long term client and production nursery, growing up to 1 million seedlings per annum for the sandalwood forestry, industry in W.A & N.T is currently trialling Plant Assist with encouraging initial results. This industry relies on strong deep roots in the tubes as, when the tubes are planted by machines in rows, if the roots are shallow, the potting medium falls off and the tree dies. In this industry it is big money to replace the tubes. We have worked with Rick for over 10 years but always look to improve quality and reduce transplant losses. We believe we can cut transplant losses further base on the early results.
